**History:** Organized in 1968 by a group of nine Dallas women who resided in Northwood Hills, NWC made an immediate commitment to helping meet the philanthropic needs of our community and improving the quality of life for others.

Over the last forty-three years NWC has raised and donated more than \$3,907,894 to local agencies and programs.

Membership to NWC includes all areas of the Greater Dallas Metroplex, and the organization unites its members at monthly general meetings and through a wide variety of educational and social interest groups.

**Community Service:** NWC enjoys a rich history of volunteer activities. This year the organization contributed a total of 12,632 hours for community service.

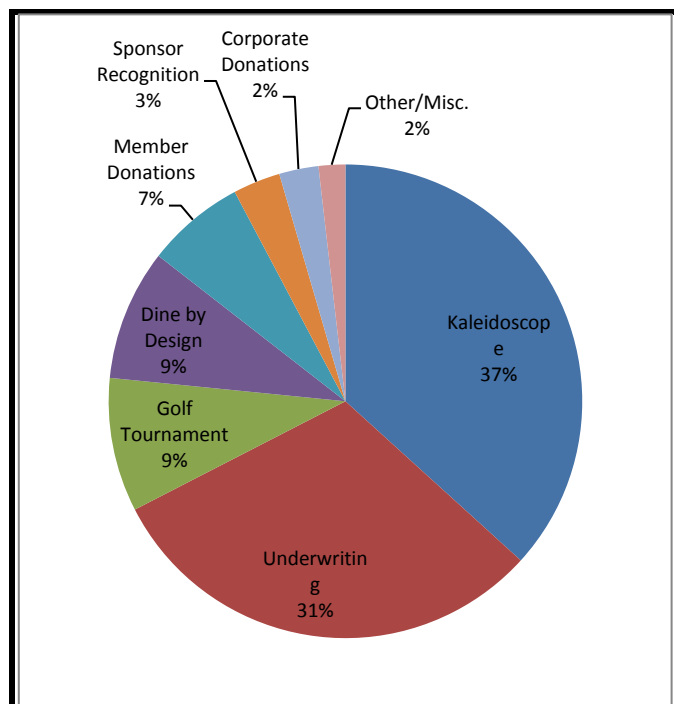

## VALUE OF VOLUNTEER TIME

**The estimated dollar value of volunteer time given in 2010 is \$21.36 per hour (from the Independent Sector web site). At this rate, NWC has contributed an additional \$264,309 in value to the Dallas community.**

This estimate acknowledges the value of the hours NWC members dedicate to making a difference with their time, talents, and energy.



## UTD Endowment

The Northwood Woman’s Club Scholarship was established in 1979 with preference given to a qualified person who had undergone a personal crisis or reversal that had produced the need for updating personal skills in order to become self-supporting.

**1979** – Northwood’s first gift to UTD was \$4,815

**1986** – Endowment established

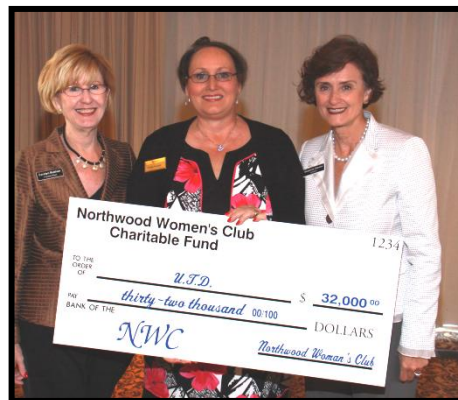
**2011** – Endowment increased \$20,000

**2011** – Endowment annually supports one full time student

**2011** – A second student is awarded a full time scholarship from Charitable Funds distribution for the year (\$10,980)

**2011** – Endowment market value is \$217,218.31

For 32 years, Northwood Women’s Club has made annual contributions to the NWC Scholarship Endowment and to individual scholarship recipients, totaling \$256,966. Since 2000, endowment distributions and annual gifts from NWC have supported twenty-three students.
